The Opportunity

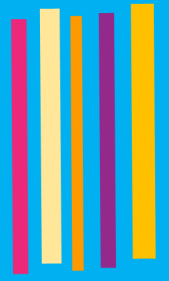
CAYAC offers young artists the experience of showing their work in a public context to a wider audience.
